January 3<sup>rd</sup>, France – Rabbi stabbed down in a Paris synagogue  
 January 9<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Montboucher-sur-Jabron beaten and insulted with antisemitic paroles  
 January 9<sup>th</sup>, France – Jewish pupil in Epinay-sur-Seine subjected to anti-Semitic insults during classes  
 January 9<sup>th</sup>, France – anti-Semitic harassment at working-place in Paris  
 January 9<sup>th</sup>, France – anti-Semitic insults in Trigulier  
 January 15<sup>th</sup>, France – teenagers physically aggressed in front of Jewish school in Paris  
 January 15<sup>th</sup>, France – two Jews physically aggressed in Paris  
 January 16<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Holocaust-survivor Rabbi Rozwaski of Berlin receives threatening letter containing ash and the parole "lies become true – Holocaust II"  
 January 16<sup>th</sup>, France – police officers in Paris question Jews for ignoring a stop sign, making anti-Semitic remarks  
 January 20<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Paris molested and subjected to anti-Semitic insults  
 January 20<sup>th</sup>, Slovakia – in Bánovce a Jewish cemetery is vandalized for the 4<sup>th</sup> time with 35 gravestones being destroyed  
 January 21<sup>st</sup>, Germany – huge anti-Semitic placard at a motorway bridge near Dortmund  
 January 23<sup>rd</sup>, France – Jew in Clarenton is insulted with anti-Semitic paroles  
 January 23<sup>rd</sup>, France – Jew is placed under custody and questioned in Verrière le Buisson after successfully defending himself against knife attack  
 January 24<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Créteil is insulted with anti-Semitic paroles  
 January 25<sup>th</sup>, Germany – murder menaces against Jewish film producer in Berlin  
 January 26<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 58 gravestones of a Jewish cemetery in Kraichtal-Oberöwisheim destroyed  
 February 1<sup>st</sup>, Greece – memorial vandalized in Thessaloniki



February 1<sup>st</sup>, Germany - tempted destruction of memorial in Bensheim  
 February 3<sup>rd</sup>, France – Jew beaten and insulted with anti-Semitic paroles in Saint-Mandé  
 February 3<sup>rd</sup>, France – two Jews aggressed as exiting Paris synagogue  
 February 4<sup>th</sup>, France – after a fight between Israelis and Arabs in Rosny-sous-Bois, an Israeli is verbally aggressed with anti-Semitic remarks and beaten during questioning by the Police.  
 February 4<sup>th</sup>, France – Jewish boy is repeatedly insulted with anti-Semitic remarks and beaten at school  
 February 14<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 30 gravestones turned over in a Jewish cemetery in Leipzig  
 February 20<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew aggressed with anti-Semitic paroles in Joinville, left hand fractured  
 February 20<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew aggressed in front of a Vincennes school, later his family is threatened  
 February 21<sup>st</sup>, France – synagogue in Eastern Paris burned down  
 February 22<sup>nd</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery in Röbel vandalized  
 February 26<sup>th</sup>, France – Paris apartment of a Jew smirched with swastika  
 February 26<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Paris insulted with anti-Semitic paroles  
 February 26<sup>th</sup>, France – anti-Semitic insults at school in Créteil  
 March Belgium – Eight Jewish students aggressed in Metro station  
 March 3<sup>rd</sup>, France – Jewish students aggressed in front of a Paris school  
 March 6<sup>th</sup>, France – Jewish shop owner in Paris harassed with anti-Semitic insults  
 March 7<sup>th</sup>, France – Jewish girl in Paris claims to be Muslim in order not to be aggressed  
 March 8<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew aggressed in Paris

March 9<sup>th</sup>, Italy – anti-Semitic paroles smirched on the office of a Jewish manager in Milan  
 March 11<sup>th</sup>, France – anti-Semitic insults in Morangis  
 March 13<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Paris asked not to wear his Kippa while at work  
 March 14<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Montmagny harassed and insulted with anti-Semitic remarks at work  
 March 14<sup>th</sup>, France – after a discussion on the situation in the Middle East, a female Jewish student is aggressed in Aix-en-Provence by masked men, insulted as "dirty Jew", Magen David carved into her arm  
 March 20<sup>th</sup>, France – Jewish family harassed at night with doorbell-ringing in Montreuil  
 March 21<sup>st</sup>, France – Jew attacked in Paris  
 March 22<sup>nd</sup>, France – Jew removing an Israeli flag with swastika is physically aggressed in Paris  
 March 22<sup>nd</sup>, France – two Jewish youths stabbed in Paris  
 March 23<sup>rd</sup>, Germany – orthodox Jew beaten up in Berlin  
 March 24<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Paris insulted with anti-Semitic paroles, aggressed, car damaged  
 March 24<sup>th</sup>, France – Jew in Saint Gratien insulted with anti-Semitic paroles and physically aggressed  
 March 28<sup>th</sup>, France – anti-Semitic insults in Essone  
 March 30<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial in Gelsenkirchen smirched with nazi-parole „Arbeit macht frei!“  
 March 30<sup>th</sup>, France – A Molotov cocktail was thrown at the synagogue in the Parisian suburb of Massy  
 March 30<sup>th</sup>, Estonia – Two Estonian youths spray-painted anti-Semitic epithets such as „Jews get out!“ in Sillame  
 March 31<sup>st</sup>, France – Jew in Paris subjected to anti-Semitic insults  
 April 1<sup>st</sup>, France – Jewish restaurant burned down in Paris  
 April 2<sup>nd</sup>, Hungary – car of the head of Jewish community in Budapest smirched with swastika  
 April 3<sup>rd</sup>, Ukraine – Swastikas were painted in a Jewish institution in Khaki  
 April 5<sup>th</sup>, Switzerland – Six Skinheads attacked Jews in a Zurich pub  
 April 14<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish shop in Berlin smirched with swastikas  
 April 15<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial tablet in Berlin stolen  
 April 15<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 52 out of 60 gravestones destroyed in a Jewish cemetery in Zwickau  
 April 15<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial tablet in Fürstenberg smirched  
 April 21<sup>st</sup>, Russia – bomb next to Moscow synagogue deactivated  
 April 21<sup>st</sup>, Turkey – Jewish doctor killed in Istanbul  
 April 27<sup>th</sup>, Sweden – attempt to set fire to Jewish cemetery in Malmö.  
 April 29<sup>th</sup>, Germany – failed attempt to set fire to Berlin synagogue



April 29<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial desecrated in Ravensbrück  
 May 1<sup>st</sup>, Germany – Woman insulted as a Jew and aggressed with the words "they seem to have forgotten another one"  
 May 4<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery in Neustadt vandalized. Slit pig left behind  
 May 9<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial stone thrown over in Bergen-Belsen  
 May 9<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish memorial stone vandalized, dead pig left behind in Lübeck  
 May 10<sup>th</sup>, Austria – rabbi in Vienna harassed and beaten in a street  
 May 11<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 56 year old man harassed as a "dirty Jew", spit at and beaten up in Berlin because wearing a Magen David  
 May 13<sup>th</sup>, Germany – orthodox Jew in Berlin insulted as "dirty Jew", chased and beaten  
 May 15<sup>th</sup>, Great Britain – 386 gravestones in Jewish cemetery vandalized in London  
 May 22<sup>nd</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery desecrated in Bad Kreuznach  
 May 26<sup>th</sup>, Belarus – memorial in Minsk desecrated



May 29<sup>th</sup>, Germany – a man in Berlin subway beaten up when asking three men not to repeat „we hate the Jews“-paroles  
 June 6<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial desecrated in Berlin  
 June 13<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Memorial at nazi KZ Ravensbrück desecrated  
 June 13<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery desecrated in Zittau with 31 gravestones thrown over  
 June 13<sup>th</sup>, Belgium – attempted carbombing attack against synagogue of Charleroi  
 June 22<sup>th</sup>, Russia – synagogue vandalized in Yaroslavl  
 June 23<sup>th</sup>, Lithuania – Jewish cemeteries in Kaunas and Kursenai vandalized  
 June 27<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 14 year old girl wearing Magen-David-necklace insulted and beaten in Berlin  
 July 1<sup>st</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery desecrated in Zittau  
 July 7<sup>th</sup>, Great Britain – Jewish cemetery in Southampton desecrated  
 July 8<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish memorial damaged by stown throwing in Berlin  
 July 16<sup>th</sup>, Lithuania – Vilnius Jewish cemetery vandalized third time in two months  
 July 20<sup>th</sup>, France – memorial desecrated in Venissieux  
 July 25<sup>th</sup>, France – synagogue in Paris vandalized  
 July 27<sup>th</sup>, Germany – placards with hate speech installed at KZ-memorial Langenstein-Zwieberge  
 July 29<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Nazi placards at KZ-memorial Sachsenhausen  
 July 29<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial stone destroyed in Köcknitz  
 August 1<sup>st</sup>, France – synagogue ravaged in Southern France  
 August 4<sup>th</sup>, Russia – bomb in Moscow with anti-Semitic remarks written on it deactivated  
 August 4<sup>th</sup>, Germany – KZ cemetery in Vaihingen desecrated  
 August 5<sup>th</sup>, Great Britain – Jewish cemetery in Manchester desecrated  
 August 18<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 56 graves destroyed in Jewish cemetery in Kassel  
 August 22<sup>nd</sup>, Germany – Jewish shop in Berlin closed down because of ongoing harassment  
 August 23<sup>rd</sup>, Germany – memorial place in Berlin desecrated  
 August 27<sup>th</sup>, Belarus – synagogue in Minsk set on fire  
 September, Germany – Museum and memorial place Belower Wald destroyed by arson attack, desecration in Grevesmühlen, Bützow and Fürstenberg  
 September 2<sup>nd</sup>, Russia – faked bomb found next to synagogue in Novgorod  
 September 9<sup>th</sup>, Germany – serious bombing attack on Munich synagogue prevented  
 September 14<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery in Strassfurt desecrated for the third time in 2003  
 September 14<sup>th</sup>, Germany – KZ cemetery desecrated in Berge  
 September 14<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 45 gravestones desecrated in Jewish cemetery Efringen-Kirchen  
 September 22<sup>nd</sup>, Germany – Garden of Jewish Museum in Berlin vandalized  
 September 24<sup>th</sup>, Germany – swastikas smirched next to Jewish cemetery Bremen  
 September 26<sup>th</sup>, Germany –anti-Semitic paroles next to Jewish cemetery in Hastedt  
 September 30<sup>th</sup>, Germany – bombing attack against Jewish Museum in Berlin and a Jewish Bar in Düsseldorf prevented  
 October 3<sup>rd</sup>, Germany – Jewish memorial in Berlin desecrated  
 October 10<sup>th</sup>, Greece – memorial in Ionnina desecrated  
 October 11<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 42 gravestones of Jewish cemetery Gudensberg desecrated  
 October 12<sup>th</sup>, Germany – desecration of memorial in Ravensbrueck  
 October 15<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery in Michelstadt desecrated  
 October 15<sup>th</sup>, Germany – 50 flyers with anti-Semitic paroles confiscated in Berlin

 November 5<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial place in Extertäl-Börsingfeld desecrated before disclosure  
 November 7<sup>th</sup>, Great Britain – synagogue in Manchester desecrated  
 November 8<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial tablet in Sprockhövel damaged before disclosure  
 November 9<sup>th</sup>, Czechia – memorial in Krupka desecrated  
 November 9<sup>th</sup>, Czechia – Jewish cemetery in Trutnov vandalized  
 November 15<sup>th</sup>, Turkey – car bombs in front of two Istanbul synagogues with 23 killed and hundreds injured  
 November 15<sup>th</sup>, France – Jewish school in Gagny destroyed after arson assault  
 November 15<sup>th</sup>, Germany – retiree caught in Regensburg after repeated anti-Semitic phone calls to Jewish community center  
 November 17<sup>th</sup>, Germany – destruction of Jewish memorial in Löcknitz  
 November 17<sup>th</sup>, France – anti-Semitic textbooks banned by government  
 November 19<sup>th</sup>, Germany – anti-Semitic paroles smirched next to memorial  
 November 20<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial in Berlin desecrated  
 November 21<sup>st</sup>, Great Britain – Jewish cemetery in Medway desecrated  
 November 22<sup>nd</sup>, Germany – synagogue in Hagen desecrated  
 November 24<sup>th</sup>, Lithuania – Jewish cemetery vandalized in Plunge

November 27<sup>th</sup>, Germany – religious Jew subjected to anti-Semitic insults in Berlin  
 November 27<sup>th</sup>, Germany – several thousand anti-Semitic newspapers confiscated in Vlotho  
 December 1<sup>st</sup>, France – 55 members of French Parliament receive e-mail with anti-Semitic contents  
 December 2<sup>nd</sup>, France – repeated physical aggression against Jewish students  
 December 4<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery in Dortmund desecrated  
 December 6<sup>th</sup>, Germany – Jewish cemetery in Achim desecrated  
 December 9<sup>th</sup>, Poland – Jewish cemetery near Auschwitz vandalized  
 December 11<sup>th</sup>, Italy – car explodes in front of Modena synagogue  
 December 16<sup>th</sup>, Germany – memorial in Berlin desecrated  
 December 17<sup>th</sup>, Russia – synagogue in Kostroma damaged  
 December 21<sup>st</sup>, Germany – Jewish Museum in Berlin smirched  
 December 24<sup>th</sup>, France – Jewish cemetery in Marseille desecrated with swastikas
